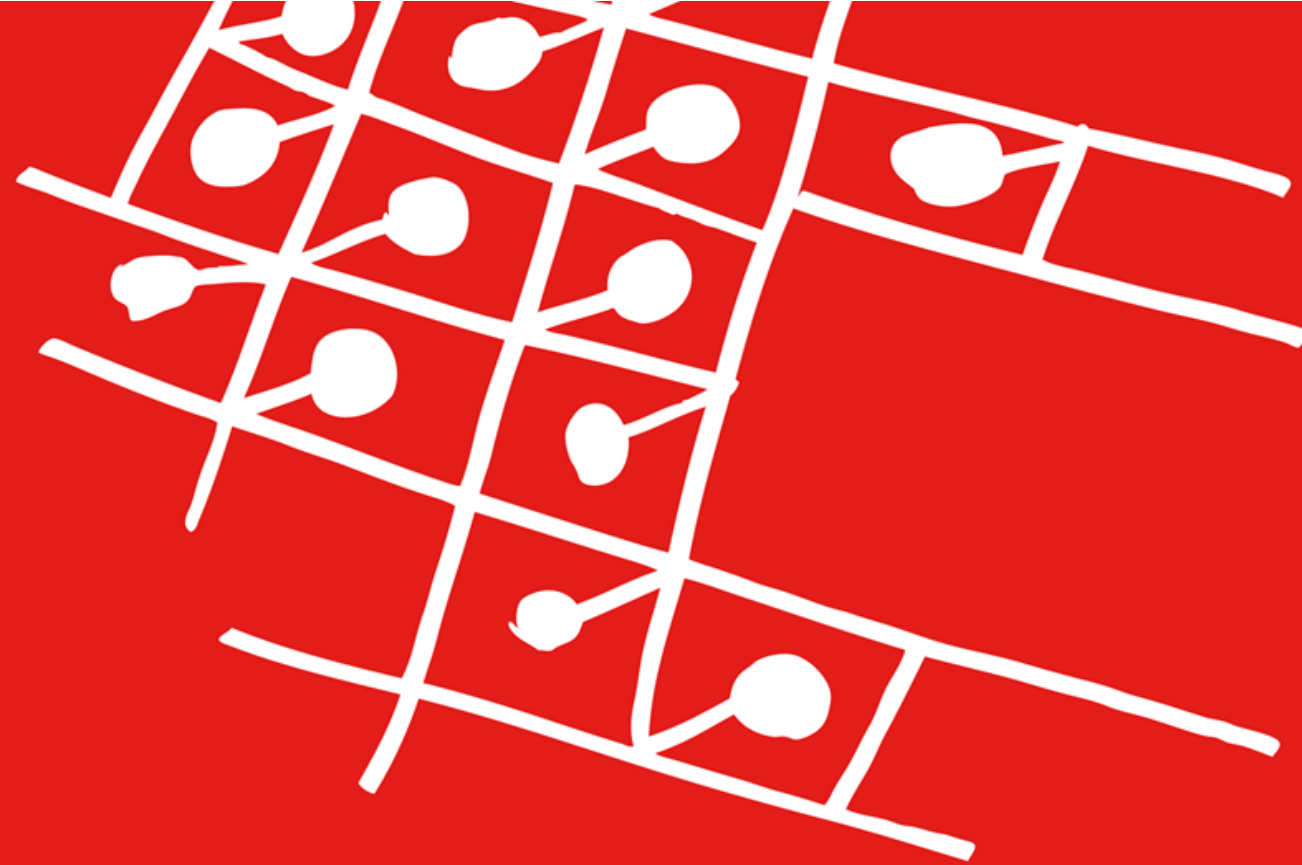

Office market in Poland

At the end of 2016, the total office stock in Poland was estimated at over 9m sq m with a diverse range of office buildings on offer mainly in the seven largest cities. The Polish office market is unique in terms of numbers of office locations when compared with other CEE countries, where almost all the stock is concentrated in one city, which is typically the capital.

Warsaw remains the dominant market with a total modern office stock amounting to 5M sq m, with a further 3.6M sq m of modern office stock located in six major regional cities: Krakow, Wroclaw, Tricity, Katowice, Poznan and Lodz.

Warsaw is the largest and the most expensive office market in Poland. Monthly asking rents range from EUR 14 to 24 per sq m in the Central Business District, while in non-central locations they vary between EUR 10.5 and 18 sq m/month. [Read on...](#)
