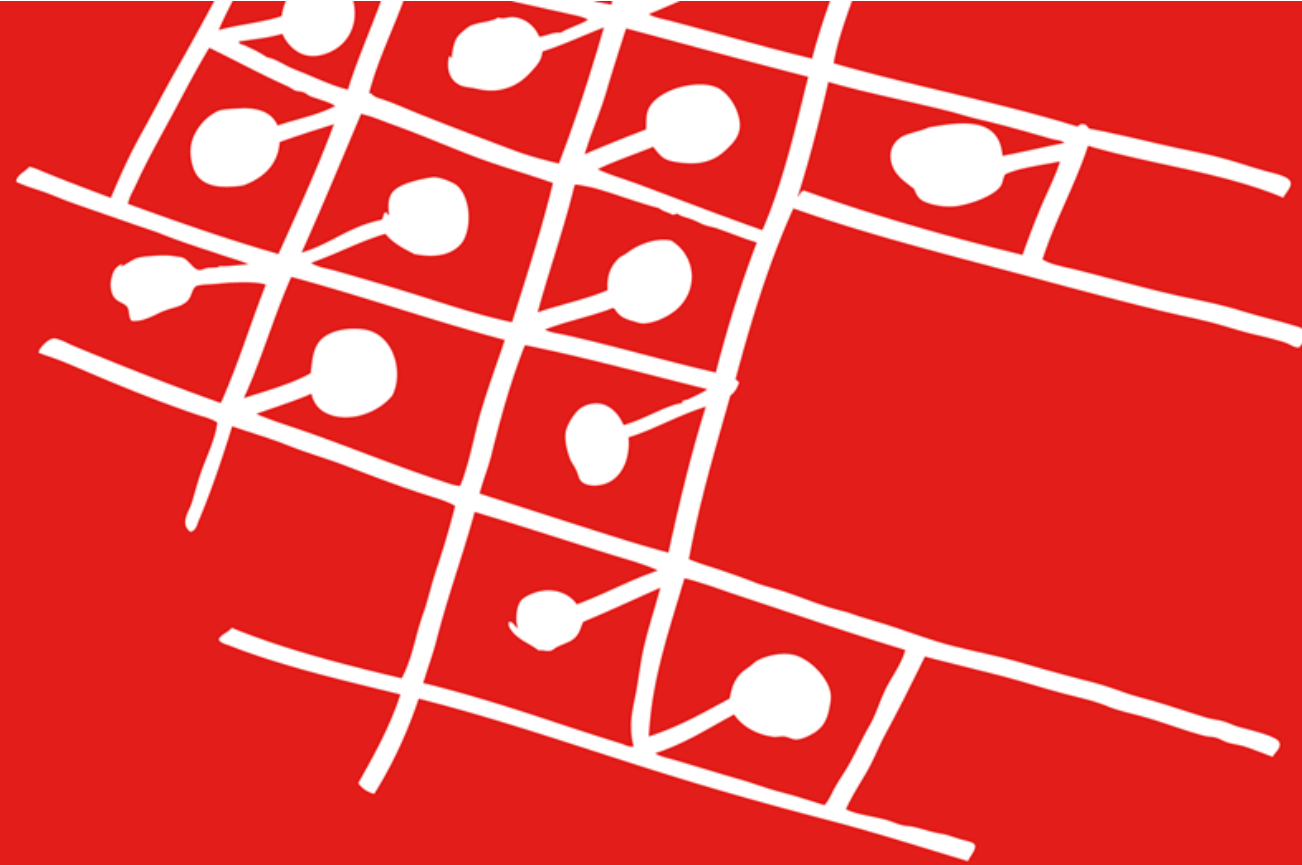

# *Market report: BSS in Poland*

In the past 12 months (Q1 2016 – Q1 2017), the number of jobs in the business services sector in Poland increased by 32,000 (i.e. by 15%),  $\frac{3}{4}$  of which were created by foreign centres. Thus, 748 business services centres owned by 524 foreign companies now employ as many as 198,000 people in Poland.

In Q1 2017, Poland was home to a total of 1,078 (Polish and foreign) business services centres employing 244,000 people. Given the industry's growth in recent years, it may be assumed that by 2020, business services centres will be employing more than 300,000 people. Out of the 724 companies with business services centres in Poland, 80 are investors featured on the Fortune Global 500 (2016) list, with 67,000 employees at 134 business services centres (27% of the jobs in the industry).
