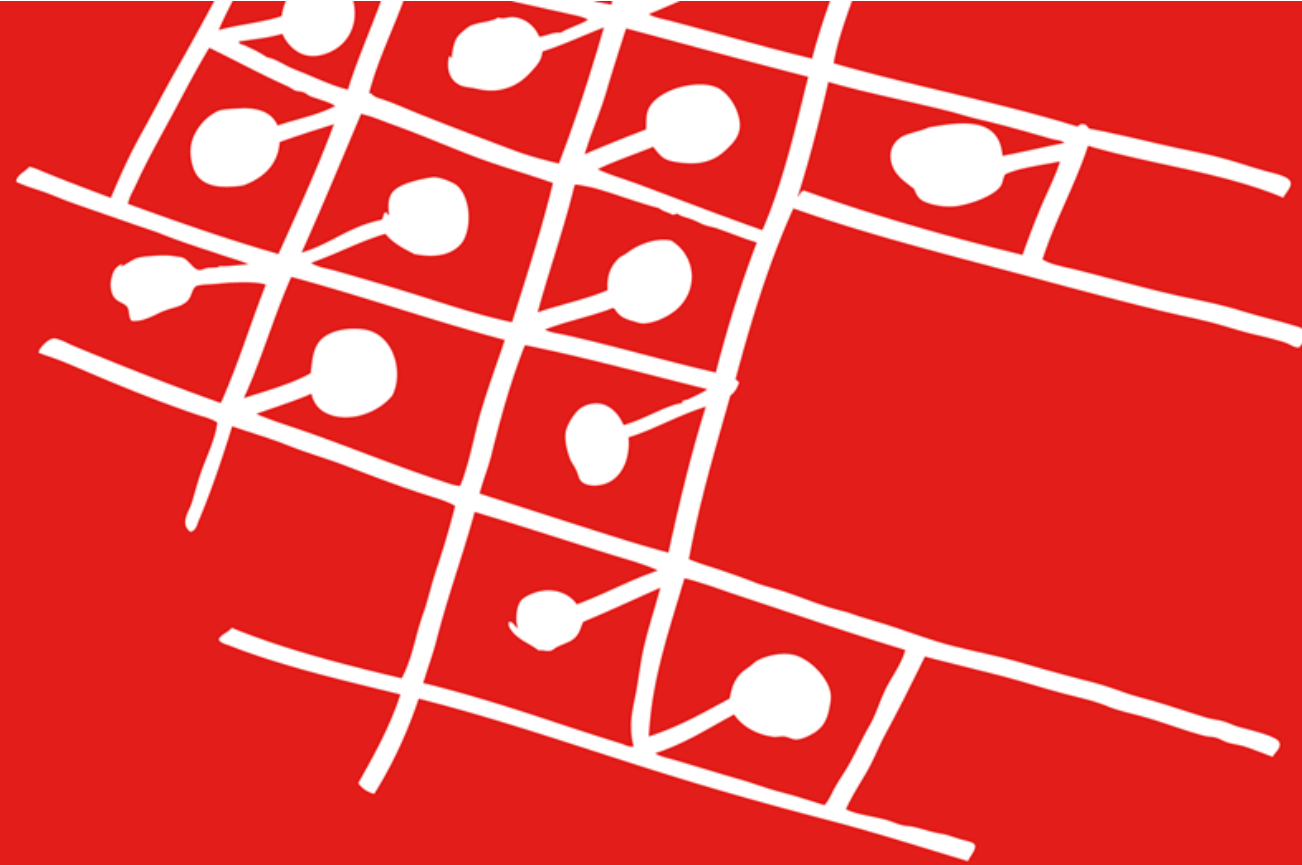

Market report: Brexit

Brexit not so dreadful for commercial cooperation with United Kingdom.

BZWBK experts has examined the impact of Britain's exit from EU to conclude that Brexit does not necessarily have to mean negative consequences for Poland.

Recent Central Statistical Office's (GUS) data show that Polish exports to UK should not be reduced in case of Brexit threat. Despite the fact that in the Q3 of 2016 (after the announcement of Brexit) the sale of Polish companies dropped down in UK, the growth trend is now clearly visible.
